



TEXAS BOOK FESTIVAL TO DISTRIBUTE NEARLY 3,000 BOOKS TO 4 HOUSTON-AREA TITLE I ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS FOR READING ROCK STARS PROGRAM

AUSTIN, TX (March 15, 2024) – On Friday, March 22, Texas Book Festival (TBF) will bring its annual Reading Rock Stars (RRS) program to Houston. 13 celebrated children's authors and illustrators will present their latest books to students in four Title I schools throughout the Houston area.

Texas Book Festival's Reading Rock Stars literacy program enlivens books for children by bringing authors to schools to share stories that ignite curiosity and excitement among young readers and provide memorable experiences to support a lifelong love of reading, writing, and creativity. To celebrate the growing bilingual community in Houston, we are thrilled to feature several bilingual authors and books in both Spanish and English.

Author visits are the culmination of several weeks of planning on the part of students, educators, and TBF staff and conclude with each student taking home a signed copy of the author's book. Since 2001, TBF will have donated 174,224 books to children across Texas through this initiative as of March 22, 2024.
